Obstructs patient valve assembly with gloved hand to determine high pressure relief	2	
Set the tidal volume, ventilator rate, and alarms if available	2	
Recheck the settings as appropriate for the patient's condition	2	
Connect the ATV to the 15/22 mm fitting on the mask or IGEL	1	
Auscultate the patient's breath sounds to ensure adequate ventilation	2	
Verbalize possible complications of ATV use	2
