**TRAUMA CRITICAL**

- Need for Ventilator support OR Respiratory Rate <10 or > 29 breaths per minute. <20 in infant aged <1 year.
- Glasgow Coma Scale <13
- Systolic Blood Pressure <90 mmHg
- Transfusing Blood
- Penetrating injury to the head, neck, chest, or abdomen and extremities proximal to elbow or knee
- Chest wall instability or deformity (e.g.) flail chest)
- Amputation above wrist or ankle
- Crushed, degloved, mangled, pulseless extremity
- Unstable pelvic fracture
- Open or depressed skull fracture
- \*Two or more proximal long bone fx's (femur or humerus)\*

**TRAUMA GUARDED**

- Burns to face, airway, >20% TBSA
- Blunt chest trauma, rib fxs, pulmonary contusion
- Limb paralysis
- Pregnancy >3 Months
- Falls
  - Adult- >20 feet
  - Children- >10 feet or two or three times patient's height
- High-Risk Auto Crash
  - Intrusion, including roof: >12 inches, occupant site; >18 inches any sight
  - Ejection (partial or complete) from automobile
  - Death in same passenger compartment
  - Vehicle telemetry data consistent with high risk of injury
  - MVA >20 mph unrestrained
  - MVA >40 restrained
  - High speed rollover
- MCA, ATV >20 mph
- Auto vs. Pedestrian/bicyclist thrown, run over or with significant impact (>20 mph)
- Bicycle >20 mph with injury
- May UPGRADE at RN Discretion**

**SPECIAL PATIENT CONSIDERATIONS**

- Older Adults
  - Risk of injury/death increases after age 55
  - SBP <110 may represent shock after age 65.
  - Low impact mechanisms (GLF) may result in severe injury
- Anticoagulants and bleeding disorders- Patients with head injury are at high risk for rapid deterioration
- May UPGRADE at RN Discretion**
